November 15.. Bremer injured his knee during practice on November 7, and didn't play again until January 3, when he made his comeback against Baylor. He sat out the final three games of the season. He had surgery on his knee after the season, and would miss the 2012-13 season, making him the third consecutive in-season leader of the Kansas Jayhawks who have missed the season due to an injury. 2011-12 Bremer had an outstanding freshman year. He averaged 13.6 ppg and 8.7 apg. He was voted to the Third Team All-Big 12. He had a career-high 34 points in the first round of the Big 12 tournament. He had three 40+ point games during his freshman year. Bremer was the only freshman to appear in all 36 games. In the 2013 NCAA tournament, Bremer scored 13 points against St. John's in the First Round and 24 points against Ole Miss in the Sweet Sixteen. A centreman from Kyneton, Mitchell was one of Geelong's leading players in the first decade of the 20th century, having left Prahran to join them from the Geelong and District Football Association (GDFA). He played in Geelong's first ever VFL match, against South Melbourne in round four of the 1905 VFL season. In the 1906 season, Mitchell kicked 21 goals and had an equal-second placing in the Geelong best and fairest. Geelong competed in the first ever interstate football match in Australia, against South Australia, at the Junction Oval on 22 June 1907. Mitchell had kicked two goals and was reported for throwing 82157476af
